Begin your journey at Providence

The following information is specific to eligibility when applying to undergraduate faculties at the University of Manitoba (U of M). Please note that the following are GENERAL statements meant to offer general direction. All students are asked to consult a current undergraduate calendar at the university of their choice. Potential U of M students should seek definitive information at the U of M web page and be aware that many professional faculties have competitive admission.

Note: Admission requirements to university programs at other institutions vary depending on the program. Variables in transferability include the program desired by the student, the courses selected at Providence, AGPA, and others. Agriculture - minimum 24 credit hours. Providence offers Economics (6 credit hours), Mathematics (6 credit hours) and the electives (3 credit hours), but does not offer Agriculture (9 credit hours), Biology (6 credit hours) or Chemistry (6 credit hours).

Architecture - 30 credit hours. Requires a mixture of Arts and Sciences, all of which are possible at Providence. Students should be careful to do both the math and writing requirements, and should plan to do the Environmental Design course at U of M during the U of M Intersession.

Art - 30 credit hours. Students apply to Fine Arts on the basis of performance in Introductory Art classes and the production of a portfolio. Other first year subjects could be taken at Providence.

Dental Hygiene - 30 credit hours. Providence offers all but the 9 credit hours of Chemistry and Zoology.

Dentistry - 30 plus 30 credit hours. Students could do the first 30 credit hours at Providence as they are largely electives and English. The second 30 credit hours would need to be done at U of M as many are Sciences.

Education - Providence offers a recognized undergraduate degree that meets the requirements for both breadth and teachable subjects in a major and a minor. Details for the Providence undergrad degree are on the Providence website under Programs, Pre-Professional, Education. Details for entrance into the various tracks, upon completion of the undergrad, are available on the U of M website.

Engineering - 24 - 30 credit hours. Providence offers the Mathematics (9 credit hours), Critical Thinking (3 credit hours) and English (3 credit hours).

Environment, Earth and Resources - 24 - 30 credit hours. As there is no specification of courses other than University level, all can be done at Providence.

Human Ecology - 24-30 credit hours. Students need 24-30 credit hours from both Arts and Sciences with a minimum of 6 credit hours of Science. All are available at Providence.

Law - 60 credit hours. These 60 credit hours can be from any university level degree program. All 60 (two years of fulltime study) could be done at Providence.

Management - Students enter by several different tracks. While there is considerable flexibility regarding which courses are accepted, high grades are important. Consult the U of M website for details.

Medical Rehabilitation - 30 credit hours. Providence offers all but the 6 credit hours of Biology/Zoology of the 30 credit hours required for entrance.

Medicine - While Providence provides the required 18 credit hours in Humanities and Social Sciences, preparation for the MCAT is best facilitated by studying Science at the U of M.

Music - Students directly out of high school or University One are admitted on the basis of an audition.

Nursing - 39 credit hours. Requires Arts and Sciences courses, which are available at Providence. Consult the U of M website for details.

Pharmacy - 30 credit hours. Providence offers all but Chemistry (6) and Biology (6).

Physical Education - Providence offers 24 credit hours of Arts and Sciences, but not the Physical Education, Recreation Studies, or the Biology courses that are strongly suggested.

Science - minimum 24 credit hours. Any selection of university level courses is accepted as transferable.

Social Work - 30 or 51 credit hours. Social work requires 30 or 51 (Advanced Standing) credit hours of university level courses such as the transferable courses offered by Providence. Students can complete the fully accredited U of M Bachelor of Social Work (BSW) in two or three years depending upon whether or not they qualify for Advanced Standing.
